Governance

TPCH Foundation is a statutory body incorporated by Queensland State Government legislation (*Hospital Foundations Act 2018 Qld*). We are a registered Health Promotion Charity (HPC) and legal entity that holds deductible gift recipient (DGR) not for profit status with the Australian Tax Office, and are required to follow strict requirements that govern our fundraising and promotion activities. To be entitled to registration as the HPC subtype of charity, an organisation must demonstrate that it is 'an institution whose principal activity is to promote the prevention or the control of diseases in human beings'. As a charity that funds and administers monies for health and medical research associated with TPCH and CKW, TPCH Foundation acquits the funds we hold in alignment with the above legal requirements. We undergo yearly auditing, with annual reporting to the Queensland Minister for Health under the prescribed requirements of the Financial Accountability Act 2009, the Financial and Performance Management Standard 2019, and the detailed requirements set out in the Annual report requirements for Queensland Government agencies.

In addition to legal requirements, the Foundation also takes seriously our obligation to administer and acquit Donor funds as per the express wishes of our generous community of supporters.
